



5th Panhellenic High-School Student Simulation of the United Nations Human Rights Committees

"Students as Diplomats"

11 - December 13, 2020

The organization of the 5th Panhellenic High-School Student Simulation of the United Nations Human Rights Committees will be held online via a web telecommuting platform to ensure safe participation of students, taking into consideration the protection measures against the spread of coronavirus. The terms and conditions of participation have been updated according to the implementation needs of this year's online event.

Terms and Conditions of Participation

The following terms and conditions govern the registration, preparation and participation in the Panhellenic High-School Student Simulation of UN Committees on Human Rights titled "Students as Diplomats"

1. Registration

1.1. Public and private high school (junior and senior) students can apply in order to participate as:

- "Diplomats": independent experts - members of the United Nations Human Rights Committees
- Journalists

1.2. Students can register for the conference either individually or in groups, following the instructions on the website "www.roh.gr" and completing the corresponding application.

In the case of individual registration, the student's parent/guardian is declared as the contact person.



In the case of group registration, the school teacher who undertakes the preparation of the group delegation of students is declared as the person in charge of communication.

After the successful submission of the (individual or group) application form and within a reasonable period of time, an email with further instructions regarding the next stages of preparation will be sent.

1.3. Conference registration includes:

- the online training material provided to the participants during the preparation period,
- the preparation of the students who will participate as diplomats, which includes, inter alia: the conduct of online working meetings with the Chairpersons of the Committees; the support for the production of the position papers of the diplomats; the acquaintance with the rules of procedure;
- the guidance and support of students who will participate as journalists, in terms of their duties within the press team and under the guidance of the editor-in-chief;
- the support of the school teachers who are in charge of the group delegations for the substantive and procedural issues related to the participation of their students in the Simulation;
- the certificate of participation, issued electronically upon completion of the conference during the closing ceremony;
- the honorary awards for the participants who will be distinguished for their performance within the Committees, which will be sent by airmail to the awarded diplomats.

1.4. Deadline:

The registration period for the conference is announced at the beginning of each school year.

For the 5th High-School Student Simulation during the school year 2020-2021, the registration period starts on September 20, 2020 and ends on October 31, 2020.

1.5. Cancellation of participation:



Cancellation of participation with a refund will be accepted up to one month before the conference. In case of a subsequent cancellation of participation, the participation fee will not be refunded. Exceptions will be made for significant reasons.

The request for cancellation of participation should be sent by email to "mrd.synedrio@gmail.com".

2. Access to appropriate equipment

Participants should have access to a computer or laptop with microphone and camera and internet connection during the conference hours. Participants should also have access to the same technical equipment during the preparation period, in order to be able to attend the online meetings that will be held by the chairpersons of the Committees.

Participants will receive the necessary instructions and access to a digital platform for their online preparation and their participation in the conference (see also section 3.3. Below).

3. Protection of personal data

3.1. Pursuant to the New European Regulation on Personal Data Protection 2016/679:

The personal data which are provided by the participants are recorded by the ROI KOIN.S.EP. are subject to process for the purposes of sending information material, announcements, newsletters, invitations and calls, while they can also be processed for statistical purposes. Personal data will be retained by the ROI KOIN.S.EP., unless you request their delete.

If you have provided personal data giving your consent to the processing of your personal data, you have the right to be informed and to correct or ask for the delete of this data at any time. This can be done by sending an email to "mrd.synedrio@gmail.com" and we will make sure that your personal data will be removed. Your personal data will not be available and will not be transmitted to third parties, who are not associated with ROI KOIN.S.EP., without your explicit consent.

ROI KOIN.S.EP. uses technology and security measures, rules and other procedures to protect personal data from any unauthorized access, misuse, disclosure, loss or destruction and maintains control and responsibility over the use of this information.

3.2. During the conduct of the Panhellenic High-School Student Simulation of the United Nations Human Rights Committees "Students as Diplomats", audiovisual material (photos



and video excerpts) from the work of the Committees will be published. In addition, after the completion of the conference, related material will be posted on the conference website where there is free access. In case it is not desirable to publish material in which a specific participant will be included, please let us know by email at "mrd.synedrio@gmail.com" at least 2 days before the start of the conference.

3.3. ROI KOIN.S.EP. will use a certified digital platform conducting online activities (both in preparation and during the duration of the Simulation), in accordance with the policies of proper use and protection of the personal data of the participants.

Participants will receive the necessary instructions and access to the digital platform for conducting online preparation meetings once their participation has been confirmed. Access to the digital platform will not be public.

4. Liability

4.1. High-School student participants are under the responsibility of their parents / guardians. By submitting the online application form, the parent / guardian (for individual applicants) or the responsible teacher (for group applications) declares that he / she is solely responsible for the consistency of the participant(s) during the conference hours.

4.2. ROI KOIN.S.EP. is not responsible in case a participant uses personal video media (eg mobile phone) in order to record excerpts of the work of the Committee during the conference.
